<b>Department Name</b>	Community Medicine (Preventive & Social Medicine)									
<b>Introduction</b>	<p>Formerly called as Preventive &amp; Social Medicine (PSM) or recently renamed as " Community Medicine", it is the art and science of preventing diseases, prolonging life and promoting physical &amp; mental health and efficiency.</p> <p>The subject is introduced to the medical undergraduates from Ist MBBS itself with an aim to sensitize them to the community. Visits to places of public health importance are organized during the 1st year. During the second year, the topics of Environmental Sanitation and Biostatistics / Health Statistics are introduced. As part of practical training, the students undergo monthly rotatory postings to Urban health Centre (UHC) and Rural Health Centre (RHTC) during which they conduct house to house surveys, family case studies, school health surveys, dietary surveys, etc. During their final year students are taught Epidemiology, Communicable &amp; Non communicable diseases and Community Health including Health Care Delivery, Primary Health Care, Nutrition, Maternal &amp; Child Health, Sociology, Family Planning &amp; Demography, Occupational Health and International Health.</p> <p>Since, the introduction of CBME in 2019, and Family adoption program in 2021, families are allotted to the students right from their first MBBS. In this context, two new areas apart from the UHC and RHTC field practice areas, have been adopted by the department as per NMC guidelines. One area in the rural community, a village named Panore in Tal: Panhala of District Kolhapur which is around 40 km away from the institute and another area in the peripheral urban slum of Rajendranagar, Kolhapur</p>

<b>Facilities</b>	<p>The Department of Community Medicine is well equipped with a library containing 205 books and over 90 journals. The dept. library also has a section for non-academic books including motivational, historical, religious, communication skills and biographies, which are useful for foundation course of MBBS students.
